Peter Phelps is a retired school teacher and artist. Originally from Springfield, MA, Phelps moved to Boston at the age of 79 to take part in a medical study to treat his lung cancer. With no place to live in Boston, Phelps stayed in shelters during this treatment. A Hearth Case Manager met Phelps and helped find him a one-

bedroom apartment in Roxbury. Able to resume his painting, Phelps donated over 80 paintings, including the one on this card, to help raise funds for the organization.

A self-taught artist, Phelps has received much recognition for his artwork, including a one-man show at Boston City Hall, and he has been featured in *The Boston Globe* and *The Boston Herald*, as well as on WBZ Radio, WBUR, and the *CBS News Sunday Morning Show*.
